<b>Location of defibrillator:</b>  Entrance to IOMFA Headquarters & behind the Home dugout & With St Johns Ambulance
<b>Location of first aid kit:</b>  IOMFA Headquarters Entrance & St John's Ambulance
<b>Location of stretcher:</b>  Behind Home Dugout St Johns Ambulance Stations
<b>Access routes:</b> For ambulance into Club: St Johns Ambulance will have a vehicle at the ground for each game.



If an additional vehicle is required access will be via the Bowl Car park (Pulrose Rd) and the ambulance will be directed to the most appropriate gate (entrance) depending upon where the person requiring attention is situated.

From pitch to ambulance: Players and people involved in the game will be taken from directly to the Ambulance that is available in the corner of the pitch.

From Club's first aid room to ambulance: Will be taken from the FA Headquarters, out of the player / staff entrance and directly to the ambulance that will be waiting at that gate.

**Nearest Hospital Emergency Department: Nobles Hospital**

Directions: Leave the Bowl Car Park. Turn Left at the traffic lights on Peel Road, Follow signs for the Hospital at quaterbridge roundabout (go straight on). Drive for ½ a mile. Turn right at the next roundabout, going up hill past Braddan school.

At the next roundabout go straight on (1<sup>st</sup> left) and the following roundabout take the 2<sup>nd</sup> exit.

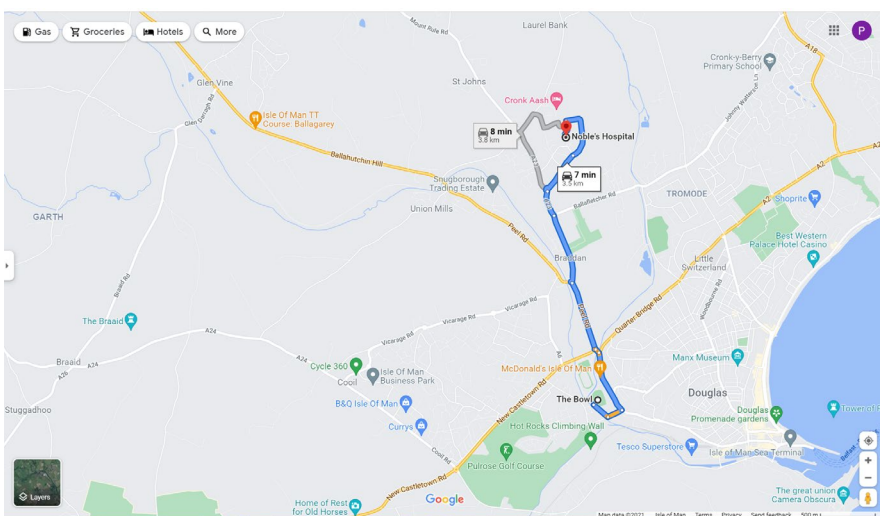
